1. BACKGROUND

The Comité d'Aide Médicale (CAM) was founded in 1990 in response to the primary health care and environment health needs in Poland and more generally in Eastern Europe. Today, the CAM has become an active agent in the provision of humanitarian and medical programs in around a dozen countries, including France.

CAM's programs aim to support communities affected by conflict, disasters and epidemics.

CAM develops its programs in partnership with local communities and prioritises the strengthening of local community capacity. The goal of CAM's work is to support communities to move from crisis to development. As a medical NGO we have a particular emphasis on a community's health needs.

Our interventions are based around three main program areas :

- Primary health care programs including mobile and fixed medical clinics.
- Environment health programs such as water and sanitation programs and community education
- Mental health programs such as psychosocial support projects which support communities and individuals traumatised by the effects of conflict or loss.

CAM structures its activities around two principal themes :

- The implementation of programs in the post-crisis stage and assisting communities to move from crisis to development
- A commitment to implementing programs which are effective and sustainable. CAM presently carries out programs in France, Sri Lanka, Central African Republic, Sudan, Angola and Mali.

2 . DEFINITION OF THE FUNCTION

General description of the post :

- Participates in the design of a plan to support and to supervise the Primary Health Centre and the mobile clinics
- Is responsible for drugs and medical supplies management
- Participates in Gender Based Violence protection and family protection programs
- Supports the preventative activities within the primary healthcare system
- Implements the project plan in PHC and mobile clinics with the medical co-ordinator; the national medical doctor and, the national Medical Assistant
- Is responsible for the collection and analysis of data from PHC and mobile clinic, participate with the medical coordinator to the analysis of those data's.
- Resume the field activities to the medical coordinator and discuss about the field problems to increase the CAM efficiency.
- Supervises and trains nurses, Community Health Workers, in collaboration with the Ministry Of Health, and CAM staff

3 . REQUIRED SKILLS

- Good written and spoken English (essential), Arabic is a plus
- Ability to live and work in an isolated area and in conditions of limited comfort
- Ability to accept the possibility of insecurity in the project area and to accept the security rules
- Previous overseas experience in humanitarian assistance programmes and basic computer skills (Word, Excel) are desirable
